


The Interface for Knowledge and Technology Transfer

BRIDGE

is the central contact point for students, alumni, and members of Bremen higher education institutions (HEIs) on the subject of business start-ups. The BRIDGE university network is funded by the University of Bremen, the Bremen University of Applied Sciences, the University of Applied Sciences Bremerhaven, Jacobs University, and Bremer Aufbau-Bank GmbH.

The BRIDGE initiative has set itself the goal of improving the start-up climate at all participating HEIs and promoting promising ideas with start-up potential at an early stage.

The offer is continuously refined and comprises three elements:

- → Consulting on general start-up topics such as funding programs (e.g. EXIST)
- → Courses on sensitization and qualification (e.g. start-up lounge, start-up workout)
- → CAMPUSIDEEN a competition for business ideas from Bremen universities.
