Information on data protection in accordance with Art. 13, 14, 21 Datenschutz-Grundverordnung (DSGVO)

Your personal data will be processed in compliance with the applicable data protection regulations, in particular the EU-Datenschutz-Grundverordnung. Below you will find all the necessary information on data processing in the context of the provision of the Deutschlandsemesterticket (D-Seti) by the University of Bremen, Niedersachsentarif GmbH (NITAG), the subcontractor Digital H GmbH commissioned by NITAG, the subcontractor IDENTA Ausweissysteme GmbH, which is also commissioned by NITAG, and the General Students' Committee (Allgemeiner Studierendenausschuss (AStA)) of the University of Bremen.

Scope and purpose of data processing

The following data is provided by the University of Bremen to the subcontractor (Digital H GmbH) commissioned by NITAG for the sole purpose of providing the D-Seti:

- 1. surname,
- 2. first names,
- 3. date of birth,
- 4. matriculation number,
- 5. eligibility period (if applicable, ticket exemption),
- 6. user name and password (log-in via Shibboleth)

The following data of students will be provided to Digital H GmbH by the AStA of the University of Bremen in the event of a ticket exemption, so that the D-Seti loses its validity during the exemption period:

- 1. surname,
- 2. first name,
- 3. date of birth,
- 4. matriculation number,
- 5. university affiliation,
- 6. eligibility period (period of ticket exemption)

The following student data will be provided by the AStA of the University of Bremen to Digital H GmbH in the event that a chip card is provided for the D-Seti so that the chip card can be manufactured and delivered:

- 1. surname.
- 2. first name,
- 3. date of birth.
- 4. matriculation number,
- 5. delivery address,
- 6. university affiliation,
- 7. matriculation status,
- 8. non-possession of a mobile device suitable for accessing and using the digital Germany semester ticket

NITAG does not process any data.

Legal basis for data processing and processed data categories

The legal basis for the data processing is Art. 6 Para. 1, Subpara. 1 lit. b and e DSGVO in conjunction with § 11 Para. 1 No. 18 Bremisches Hochschulgesetz (BremHG).

Duration of data storage

The University of Bremen provides the required data from the student management system via Shibboleth for the duration of the respective ticket validity or for the duration of the exemption from D-Seti, i.e. temporarily, for the current and future semester, and sends students entitled to tickets an e-mail with the link to access D-Seti.



The AStA of the University of Bremen collects the data required for the application process for exemption, reimbursement and chip card provision directly from the students submitting the application and transmits the data required for the purpose of blocking digital access to D-Seti or for producing and sending the chip cards to Digital H GmbH.

The data collected by the AStA of the University of Bremen as part of the application process for exemption, reimbursement and chip card provision will be deleted by the AStA of the University of Bremen no later than 12 months after the end of the semester in which the application was submitted.

The data required for the provision of D-Seti and provided to Digital H GmbH will be deleted by Digital H GmbH no later than 12 months after the end of the entitlement.

NITAG does not store any data.

Recipients of the data

Your data will only be processed by the University of Bremen for the specified purposes and for the responsible departments and persons.

Digital H GmbH processes the data to issue the digital Deutschlandsemesterticket in the form of a barcode. Since this is a personal ticket that is not transferable, the following data is required:

- 1. surname.
- 2. first names,
- 3. date of birth,
- 4. matriculation number,
- 5. university affiliation,
- 6. eligibility period,
- 7. Ticket exemption (if applicable)

The following data is collected and processed for the chip card:

1. Surname,

- 3. Date of birth,
- 4. Student ID number.
- 5. Start of validity (enrolment status),
- 6. Delivery address,
- 7. Affiliation to the university,

We would like to point out that although the transport companies are also responsible, they do not receive the above data. NITAG does not receive any data either.

Your data will only be transmitted to third parties if there is a data protection authorization to do so. This includes: Norddeutsche Landesbank

If students apply for a refund of semester fees that have already been paid, the students' account information is collected and, if the application is approved, transmitted to Norddeutsche Landesbank for the respective refund to be made by bank transfer. The following data is collected and transmitted:

- 1. account holder,
- 2. IBAN,
- 3. BIC (for transfers abroad),
- 4. amount to be refunded

Data processing does not take place outside the European Union.

We will neither sell your personal data to third parties nor market it in any other way.

Your rights

Affected persons have the right to request information from the persons responsible about the personal data concerning them, as well as to correct incorrect data or to delete it if one of the reasons stated in Art. 17 DSGVO applies, e.g. if the data is no longer required for the purposes pursued. There is also the right to restrict processing if one of the conditions specified in Art. 18 of the DSGVO applies and, in the cases of Art. 20 of the DSGVO, the right to data portability. If data is collected on the basis of Art. 6 (1) 1 lit. e (data processing for



the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller) or lit. f (data processing for the purposes of the legitimate interests), the data subject has the right to object to the processing at any time for reasons arising from his or her particular situation. We will then no longer process the personal data unless there are demonstrably compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.
